An intake process will assess a potential resident's desire for recovery and the spiritual environment the program intends to offer.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Residents are expected to embrace actions that reflect their desire to live a life free from the struggles that have hindered them and become the men Christ intended them to be. Residents are expected to:

- Attend Sunday services (11AM) at Inner City Church
- Attend an approved small group (Bible study), Celebrate Recovery, or similar program weekly
- Engage in goal-setting and personal development with a staff pastor or approved mentor
- Attend weekly house meetings and abide by all house rules
- Be meaningfully employed
- Pay program fees ("rent") on time (\$75 - \$100 a week, depending on room selection)
- Contribute through attitude and actions to an environment supportive of the recovery of other residents
- Sign out and in on the resident accountability board
- Stay clean and sober - residents will be required to submit to random alcohol and drug testing
- A one month commitment to the program is required. Although residents are empowered to achieve other living arrangements, residents can stay as long as they are clean and sober and meet the program requirements.

HOUSING ARRANGEMENTS

Residents have private or shared rooms and communal dining and living spaces. Basic cleaning, kitchen, and bathroom supplies are provided. Residents purchase and prepare their own food. Residents are assigned a chore. Failure to clean up after oneself or complete the assigned chore can result in fines or eviction.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

The program provides a Christ-centered living environment within the context of a local church.

- Support finding employment through the Dream Center resource center and computer lab
- Easy access to supportive ministries including food pantry, clothing closet, and other services
- Pastoral care by staff and access to on-site Bible studies, worship services, and fellowship groups
- Coaching in setting and achieving personal goals (ie, personal finance, education, etc)
